Dear Brothers of Champagnat,

Once again, a canonical year is ending and another one is soon starting. Hence, I use the opportunity to thank God for journeying with us throughout the last year and also enabling us to commence a new year. Let me also seize this opportunity to appreciate each one of you, dear marvellous companions, for your fidelity and witness of life over this past year. I acknowledge with gratitude your availability, commitment, and hard work in your ministry to the children and young people in your charge. Thank you for all the measures and protocols you instituted in your schools and in communities to combat the spread of COVID-19 pandemic. I also appreciate the different ways you supported the vulnerable ones during this time of pandemic. May God richly bless each one of you!

As we start off this canonical year, I invite you to continue to live the experiences and moods of our last retreats in Yaoundé and Divo. As you well know, the focus of the two retreats was on our shared life. The 22<sup>nd</sup> General Chapter invites us to live the New La Valla with **passion** and **renewed** commitment. We are invited to become 'lighthouse for each other'. We are called to build and to 'become agents of communion in our communities'. Our Marist documents regularly and untiringly remind us that 'being Brother and building up Brotherhood is our primary mission'. Therefore, let us showcase our Marist family spirit by witnessing communion and life-giving hope in our communities. This way, we fulfil the desires of St. Marcellin Champagnat: "love one another as Jesus Christ has loved you. May they be among you but one heart and one mind". Our Marist communities should be homes where each and every Brother is helped to centre his life on Jesus and helped to grow in fraternal love for one another.

Unfortunately, many of us still live in individualism, egoism and aloneness. During my canonical visitations to some communities, I noticed Marist Brothers, living in a community with resentment, anger, hurts, and unforgiveness. Brothers who live together but despise and/or are envious or jealous of each other. Brothers cannot sit together at table for a chat. How can we declare we are Brothers living 'a Marist community life' but are not on talking terms? What do we witness to? If two Brothers cannot reconcile after a misunderstanding, how can we reconcile our staff or even students and pupils? How can we give what we do not have?

Dear Brothers, our first ministry as Consecrated Religious persons, is our ability to dialogue and reconcile with each other in our community. We are supposed to be agents of reconciliation and signs of communion. In his letter to the Corinthians St. Paul admonishes them to “get rid of all bitterness, passion, anger ..... no more shouting/insults, no more hateful feelings of any sort. Instead, be kind and tender hearted to one another, and forgive one another as God has forgiven you in Christ (4: 29-32). Let us adhere to this invitation to **recreate** our communities.

Dear Brothers, you have been posted to this community and given a specific task or mission, as indicated below, because we think that your services are required in this area. Therefore, I urge you all to accept your appointment and assignments in good faith and be committed to your new community and mission for the good of the District. Your appointment is in line with the call of the XXII General Chapter that exhorts us to be open in all simplicity and to make ourselves available to go anywhere we are sent. As the same XXII Chapter document states, “our vocation implies an availability to go anywhere in our Marist world where we are called to work with children and young people, to transform the world”. This, I understand, is the will of God for you!

In addition, we have revised the Commissions and created Teams to support the Council in operationalising the District. The Constitutions remind us that, “by our religious profession, we become co-responsible for the Institute. This co-responsibility finds expression in the different tasks entrusted to us and develops within the structures set up by our proper law” (C 119). Hence, all Brothers in the District (except Students and those in Mission Ad Gentes, Lavalla200 or special assignments in Rome) have been assigned to a commission or a team to perform a task for the smooth operation of the District. I encourage the chairmen of these groups, as well as members, to make use of the current communication platforms (Zoom, Skype, Microsoft Teams, WhatsApp, etc.) for meetings. I will soon send you some operational guidelines or functional indicators to guide your functioning.

In conclusion, dear Brothers, it is expected that you report in your new communities by **1<sup>st</sup> September, 2020**. I encourage you to create sufficient time that allows you to formulate the Community Life Plans, Community and School Budgets and, please, to submit them **on or before 29<sup>th</sup> September, 2020** through the District Secretary/Bursar for Council consideration and approval. In this way, the Provincial Council can approve them in November. Let us promise that meeting of deadlines for this year will be a priority. The provincial and his council has never been enthused receiving and approving the District budget in January/February instead of October/November.

As you draft the budgets be aware of the impact of coronavirus pandemic on our scarce financial resources. Therefore, be considerate and make little sacrifices!

Thank you for your cooperation and I leave you all in the good company of Mary, Our Good Mother. It is my prayer that our merciful God will successfully guide us through this new canonical year. May our shared life this new year be worthwhile and may it generate in us a new life for our mission.


